The Many Faces of Ministry

I have often believed we must come to a new level of wholistic thinking to impact our world for the next generation. If we are going to help the hurting; educate the young; protect at-risk children; revitalize underserved communities; feed the homeless; provide affordable housing; and more, we must be more than people who shout and run around in church.

The need for strategic thinking and alliances is critical. I recently had a chance to sit on a panel with some of my good friends in business who are the backbone of the *T.D. Jakes Group* marketplace endeavors to reshape our lives, homes, and futures. I wanted to share some snippets from that fascinating conversation, unveiling the many forms of ministry.

My good friend, Reverend Khary Bridgewater, a principal at one of the 10 largest accounting networks in the world, had this to say:

“The biggest hurdle for Christian businesses is overcoming fear. So many

people are afraid to trust their own insights and instincts.

“Many also fear doing the work it takes to learn how to access capital flowing into their business. Many small businesses are one-sided, only focusing on the things they enjoy doing while ignoring hard things that will cause their business to explode.”

The agonizing reality is that we enjoy living within the bounds of our comfort zones when true success stems from disruption. If we're going to achieve something we've never achieved before, we must be willing to think and act outside the lines we feel safest in. During our special discussion panel, my ministry partner, Tiffany Brinkley, director of our main outreach arm, *United MegaCare*, shared how God wants to use us to impact communities both locally and abroad:

“We can all be change agents, and real ministry starts outside the church in the streets. United MegaCare is doing just that in Africa, the Caribbean, India, the

Philippines, and more. We are boots on the ground, pursuing long-term change. Partnership is the key. If we can't make it to a region, there's always a local connection who can assume the work and help people in crisis.

"We also firmly believe real charity begins at home. That's why we labor hard in America to create awareness in our local communities about available resources to build lives and neighborhoods."

One of my favorite parts about this sentiment is the idea of working inter-connectedly to achieve something far too big to do so alone. That's how big our goals should be. They should require us to reach out and relinquish the control of doing it by ourselves.

That's why I also invited one of our *Potter's House* pastors, Michael Phillips, who heads up *T.D. Jakes Enterprises* and our new *Good Soil* business initiative, to share his thoughts.

"We started Good Soil because we wanted a space where entrepreneurs could evolve. We are providing small-business owners with the tools they need to grow and scale their businesses for sustainability.

"Everyone needs help, connection, and resources if they're going to thrive in business."

Cassius Butts, who runs *Capital Fortitude Business Advisors* consulting firm, added to the conversation with his thoughts on the critical topic of homeownership:

"We all can own a home. Every state has funds available for people to qualify to be a first-time buyer. Tools are available for people to learn how to be home and business owners."

The last panelist, Dr. Natasha Gresham, director of the *Center of Counseling and Behavioral Health* at *The Potter's House*, had some crucial things to share about mental health in our communities.

"A lot of times, the faith community doesn't understand what mental health is. Not everyone has a mental illness, but we all have mental health. True mental health is how you live, how you love, and how you laugh. How we show up in the world reflects our mental health."

Ministry is a multifaceted way of serving the people of God. Jesus cares about every aspect of our being. It's time people get what they need to engage their passion and produce plans that benefit our homes and communities at large. ✝
